

Confidentiality and Protection

of Member Protected Health Information

Champion is committed to protecting the member's protected health information (PHI). When a member completes an application for coverage, his/her signature authorizes Champion to collect PHI (including both medical information, and data such as address and telephone number). This general consent, as well as the HIPAA Privacy Rule, allows Champion to communicate with physicians and other providers regarding a member's treatment and payment. Champion protects oral, written, and electronic PHI across the organization.

Champion also participates in quality measurement activities that may require employees to access PHI. Champion has created policies and procedures to protect such information from inappropriate use or disclosure. We will not disclose, sell or otherwise use PHI unless permitted by law, and then only to the extent necessary to administer the health plan. We will obtain written authorization from the member to use his/her PHI for any other purpose.

Champion has policies to protect the rights of any prospective or current members unable to give consent. These policies permit member's legally authorized representative to give consent on the member's behalf.

Through its contracts with providers, Champion has policies in place to allow members to inspect their medical records maintained by providers and, when needed, to include a written statement in such records. As a HIPAA Privacy right, members also have the right to review their records maintained by Champion.
